## ACHIEVEMENTS OF NE DIVISION FROM 2014 TO 2017

- 1. The overall security situation in the North Eastern States improved substantially in 2017. The number of insurgency related incidents in the region decreased by 36% compared to 2016 (2016-484, 2017 - 308). The year 2017 witnessed the LOWEST number of insurgency incidents since 1997. Security forces casualties in the region declined from 17 (2016) to 12(2017) and civilians casualties from 48 (2016) to 37 (2017). Similarly, kidnapping/abduction incidents also declined by 40% (2016- 168, 2017 – 102). Counter Insurgency Operations led to neutralization of 57 militants, arrest of 995 militants and recovery of 432 weapons in 2017 in the region. Compared to 2013, insurgency incidents declined significantly by 58%, civilians casualties by 66%, SFs casualties by 34% and kidnapping/abduction cases by 67% in the region in 2017.
- Sustained Counter-Insurgency Operations against National Democratic Front of Bodoland/Saoraigwra [NDFB/S] are continuing since Dec. 2014. As on 31.12.2017, 1015 cadres/linkmen of NDFB/S have been arrested while 60 militants killed in operations with recovery of huge quantity of arms and ammunition.
- 3. A framework agreement was signed with National Socialist Council of Nagaland/IsakMuviah [NSCN/IM] on 03.08.2015. Ceasefire agreements signed with National Socialist Council of Nagaland/Reformation [NSCN/R] and National Socialist Council of Nagaland/ Neopao Konyak -Kitovi [NSCN/NK] have been extended upto 27.04.2018.

- 4. ANVC [Achik National Volunteers' Council] and ANVC/B, militant outfits of Meghalaya, signed Memorandum of Settlement (MoS) with the Government and dissolved in December, 2014.
- 5. In Assam, Suspension of Operation (SoO) agreements signed with National Democratic Front of Bodoland/Progressive(NDFB/P) and National Democratic Front of Bodoland/Ranjan Diamary (NDFB/RD) of Assam have been extended upto 30.06.2018. There has been SoO with United Liberation Front of Assam (ULFA) since 3.9.2011 and peace talks are continuing.
- 6. A total of 23 UG outfits of Manipur, under two conglomerates (United Progressive Front [UPF] 8, Kuki National Organisation [KNO]-15) are under Suspension of Operation with the Government. SoO agreements signed with these groups have been extended upto 31.8.2018. Political dialogue with these groups commenced in June, 2016.
- 7. So far 1622 Bru families (8,573 persons) have been repatriated from Tripura to Mizoram. Remaining 5,407 Bru families (32,876 persons) have been identified to be repatriated to Mizoram.
- 8. For strengthening bilateral relations, financial assistance/aid to the tune of Rs. 8,90,46,695/- has been provided to Government of Bangladesh for establishment of an IT Centre at Bangladesh Police Academy, Sardah Rajshahi on 11.08.2016.
